## **Forty Years of Publications** in WILDFOWL

## 1948 - 1987

The Wildfowl Trust was founded on 10th November 1946. Its first Annual Report was published in 1948 and a volume then appeared annually (except for 1953), the publication becoming more and more an international scientific journal. This progression was fully recognised in 1968 when the nineteenth volume was retitled WILDFOWL 19. Thus the volume numbers run unchanged through the complete series. The Wildfowl Trust considers the provision of this annual to be one of its services to international conservation

A great variety of subjects concerned with wildfowl and other waterfowl, and their wetland habitats, has been covered in papers from all over the world. Many readers have asked for an index, but it would not be economically feasible to publish a satisfactorily detailed one. Instead, as a special commemorative supplement we are now publishing a list of over seven hundred of the papers that have appeared, simply in alphabetical order of the authors' names.

The titles listed are original papers and do not include the regular reports of Trust activities, nor those of wildfowl observed, counted or ringed. These may be sought in the appropriate annual volume. Also excluded are obituaries, book reviews and ephemera.

The List provides a first insight into the stored riches. When they were being entered in the computer, the papers were also coded on their contents with regard taxa (60 species or groups of species), subject (40 groups) and geographical area (25 groups). It is thus possible to produce lists of publications under these headings or any combination of them. Researchers who would like to avail themselves of this facility should write stating their requirements and willingness to pay a small servicing charge.
